



**Northern California Bowling Center's
"Super" Summer Jubilee State Finals
2008 Tournament Rules
This event is USBC Certified**



Eligibility: Teams shall consist of four (4) members and must have bowled in a 2008 Nor Cal BC Summer Jubilee League. Teams, whose individual averages combined together upon entering at the league level, may not exceed 780. Any team found to have entered a "Super" Summer Jubilee League in excess of the 780 maximum entering average will not be allowed in the Nor Cal BC state finals. Three games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes. This is a USBC Certified Tournament. All Jubilee League Bowlers must provide a current USBC certification cards at the State Finals.

Multiple Participation: Teams may participate in the tournament, with as many leagues as they qualify from. Teams who constitute a duplicate team (3 or more of the same bowlers), may cash more than once in the prize list, providing they bowled as the original team in more than one Jubilee league. Teams using a substitute may not bowl as a duplicate team.

Averages for the State Finals: Bowlers will use the HIGHEST of the following:

- A. Ending Jubilee League average from 2008. (12 games or more).
- B. Entering Jubilee League average that was determined in one of the following ways:
 1. Highest 2007-2008 verifiable USBC certified winter league average as of April 15, 2008.
 2. Highest 2006-2007 verifiable USBC certified winter league average as of April 15, 2007.
 3. New Bowlers entering jubilee without one of the above averages will use their ending USBC certified jubilee average with 12 or more games.

Any bowler not having bowled 12 games or more will be ineligible for the finals.

League Secretary or League Officials Must Provide a Final Standing Sheet Along with Completed Entry Forms.

Handicap: Handicap will be 90% of the difference of the team's average from 840.

Substitutes: A team requiring a substitute bowler for the Nor Cal BC State Finals Tournament may select any Jubilee League Bowler who has 12 Games or more, and whose Highest Jubilee League Average, added to those of the remaining team members, will not cause the total of the four bowlers to exceed the 780 team maximum. A bowler may substitute only once. Emergency substitutes will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

Ratio & Prize Money: Prize money will be paid on a basis of one for every four teams bowling in the State Finals. Prize money will be paid out 100%. Prize Fund \$74.88, Lineage \$39.00, exp \$34.32 per team. Total pinfall plus handicap will determine standings on prize list.

Reporting of Prize Winnings: Nor Cal BC rule will apply to this tournament. Anyone who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300.00 or more in the position standings prize list in any event in a tournament, including all events, special features, special prizes and donated prizes, within the past 12 months must inform the tournament management prior to bowling for a possible re-rating. Bowlers who have won \$600.00 or more in each of 3 tournaments in the past 24 months (from date of entry) must report those winnings. Nor Cal BC will provide a winnings report. Failure to comply with these rules could cause disqualification from this event.

Re-Rates: All prior re-rates & re-rate refusals will apply to this tournament. The tournament director, Nor Cal BC and all participating centers reserve the right to re-rate any person. Any re-rate shall become effective for all qualifying play occurring after date of re-rate. USBC rules 319d & 319e will apply to this tournament.

Optional "Alibi Side Doubles": A best 2 out of 3 doubles will be conducted at the finals. Entry Fee is \$5.00 per person (\$10.00 per doubles team). You will use the same scores rolled in the Jubilee Finals but will drop your low game. The average you use is the same as the Jubilee average. Handicap will be given based on 90% of 420. Bowl with anyone or everyone on YOUR TEAM. Prize money will be paid to 1 in every 10 doubles teams. There is no limit the number of times that you may cash.

Tournament Dates: September 13, 14, 20, 21, 2008

For Scheduling Consideration: Entries received by September 5, 2008, will have priority scheduling considerations.

(Entries will be accepted up to and including the start of the final squad on September 21, 2008)
