The Maximum Entering Team Average is 780!

2010 "Super Summer Jubilee" Rules & Guidelines For Forming Your Jubilee Leagues



For the purpose of forming teams in your league, there are certain rules that must be followed in order for your teams to be eligible to bowl in the state finals.

League Entering Averages:

A team's maximum league entering average ***MUST NOT EXCEED 780.***

For the purpose of forming teams in your leagues use the highest of the following:

- 1) Bowlers will use their **HIGHEST** 2009-2010 or 2008-2009 **verifiable** league average as of April 15, 2010.
- 2) If none of the above, bowlers will use their highest verifiable 2009 Summer Average with 21 or more games as of August 31, 2009.
- 3) **NEW BOWLERS** - (Bowlers without one of the above averages) Bowlers entering the league without an established average, may be taken into the league at whatever average is acceptable to the Directors Captains, and Elected Officers of the league as long as the total of the four people on the team ***Does Not Exceed 780.*** Leagues allowing bowlers without one of the above and have bowled in a league prior to the last 2 years must establish a rule to determine what average will be use to determine teams entering average.

Note: If a team adds a new bowler during the league season, that team's average may not exceed the 780 maximum. The new team average is calculated by using the "Entering" averages **NOT** "Current" averages.

Substitutes for the State Finals:

A team requiring a substitute bowler for the Nor Cal BC State Finals Tournament may select any Jubilee League Bowler who has 12 Games or more, and who's Highest Jubilee League Average does not exceed the 780 Maximum average, using the ending Jubilee averages. A bowler may substitute only once.

All on site Emergency substitutes are at the Discretion of the Tournament Director.

- ⇒ In order for a bowler to be **Eligible** to advance to the State Finals, bowlers **Must Have a Minimum of 12 games** in a Jubilee League.
- ⇒ Bowlers who entered a Jubilee League as a NEW bowler without an entering average will use there ending Jubilee Average at the State Finals.

The following criteria MUST be used by all centers:

- ⇒ **Jubilee Leagues Must** have League Registration Forms and Sponsor Fees sent to Nor Cal BC within **4 weeks after the start of their league.**
- ⇒ **A copy of your league rules Must be sent with Each Jubilee League** Registration Form. (1 set of rules for each Jubilee League).
- ⇒ **All Jubilee Leagues Must Be USBC Certified.** Please keep a record of your league bowlers USBC card numbers, as they will be required on the State Final Entry Forms.
- ⇒ **Bowlers Must Present Their Certification Cards at the State Finals. ***NO EXCEPTIONS*****
Note: Some bowlers will be purchasing a new card when they sign up for their 2009/10 Fall Leagues, Remind your Bowlers to **KEEP their 2009/2010 winter or summer league Certification Cards** for the State Finals.
- ⇒ **A League will not be allowed** to send more than 1/2 of the league teams to the Jubilee State Finals.
Exception: An odd number of teams in your league. In the event of an odd # of teams, example: 7, 9, and 11, teams a league will have the option to pay for the extra team to advance to the finals.

ALL CENTERS WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE SUPER SUMMER JUBILEE MUST BE A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING WITH NOR CAL BC
