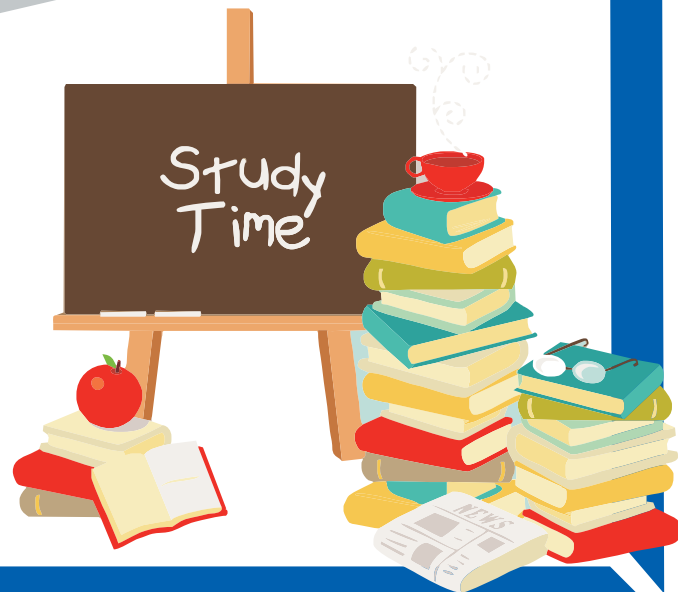
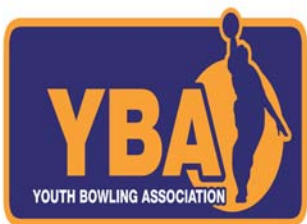

Scholarship Availability

Scholarship funds are available to students who can show proof of registration for 9 or more units or the equivalent of in one of the approved educational institutions. The recipients have until their 22nd Birthday to claim their Scholarship money. Requests for funds after the 22nd Birthday must be made in writing for the balance of any funds and will be looked at on a case by case basis. NCBC approves the eligibility of all requests and all decisions are final.

*Military - NCBC offers a one time Military exemption.

Scholarship Use

You may use your scholarship at the following approved educational institutions accredited universities and colleges, business schools, continuing educational courses, technical trade schools, trade schools, and vocational schools. NCBC approves the eligibility of all requests and all decisions are final.

NCBC Scholarship funds may not be used for . . . transportation expenses, normal school supplies, clothing expenses, camps, private tutor fees, and private primary and secondary school tuttion.

Scholarship Criteria

- 50% Academics
- 25% Bowling Participation
- 15% Personal Presence and Conduct (on and off the lanes)
- 10% Bowling Performance
- *100% Bowling Improvement / Sean Rash Scholarship
- *100% Community Service / Malatesta Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility

1. Must Currently be a Nor Cal YBA Youth bowler in good standing.
2. Must not have been a previous recipient of the same Scholarship in which applying for
3. Must currently be a Junior or Senior in High School or currently enrolled in an approved educational institute.
4. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. (Exception - Sean Rash 2.0)

Scholarship Requirements

1. Application form and required documents must be completed in full.
No points will be awarded for incomplete information.
2. A copy of School Transcripts for grades 9th - 10th - 11th & 12th grades or approved educational institutes.
3. Personal References - a minimum 2 letters of recommendation. One academic reference and one from a non - related individual.
4. A personal letter by the applicant stating any other Bowling Accomplishments and contributions to the promotion of youth bowling.

Scholarship Requirements cont. .

5. *Malatesta Scholarship Requirements:

- a. A Copy of High School Transcripts, if in college a current transcript must accompany the Scholarship form.
- b. Bowling Center References: A letter of recommendation from either the proprietor or youth director or coach.
- c. School References: A letter of recommendation from the School you are attending.
- d. Family References: Letter/s from family members to recommend nominee.
- e. Community References: Letter from community organization/s.
- f. Personal Letter from Applicant: Your own personal letter explaining all your volunteer work, school activities etc.

6. *Sean Rash Scholarship Requirements:

- a. Must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- b. Personal Reference: A minimum of 2 letters of recommendation to include your Personal Presence and Conduct. Bowling Participation and Achievements.
- c. Must have participated in 5 of 7 Nor Cal BC Tournaments: (Jr - Adult Doubles and Team Event; Nor Cal Youth Doubles Event; Nor Cal State, Doubles, Team and Singles Event; International Family Tournament.)
- d. Write a short essay on why you think you deserve this scholarship for your bowling contributions, achievements and improvement.
